WORLD HERITAGE DAY



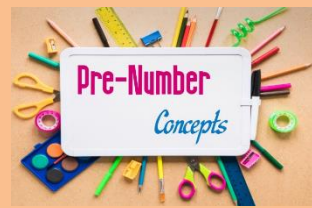
Our little ones went on a virtual tour via Smart TV to explore amazing monuments like the India Gate, Lotus Temple, and Taj Mahal.

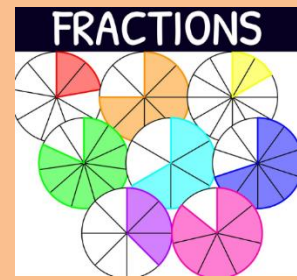
