SCIENCE ACTIVITY



. Magnetic field lines around a bar magnet can be visualized by placing the magnet under a sheet of paper and sprinkling iron filings on top. When the sheet is gently tapped, the filings align along the magnetic field, forming clear patterns from the north pole to the south pole. The filings cluster more densely near the poles, showing stronger magnetic regions.

Students of grade 7A performed this activity in the Physics lab.

2. To perform neutralisation reaction in Chemistry lab: An acid and a base are mixed to form salt and water. Rise in temperature of the product can be observed as the above reaction is an exothermic reaction



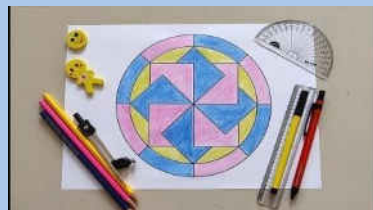

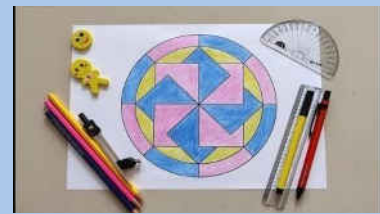
This experiential activity nurtured concentration, creativity, and geometric thinking, proving that learning can be joyful, calming, and inspiring.

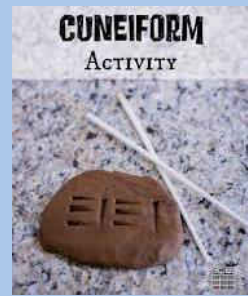

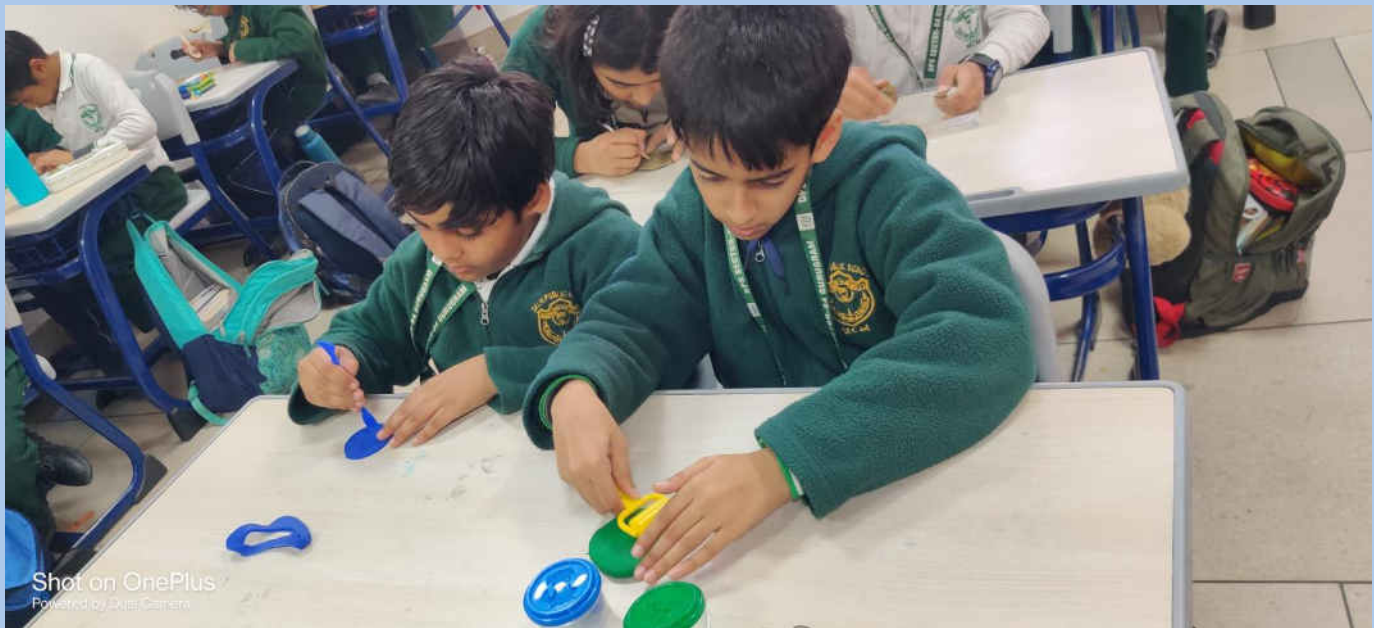


CUNEIFORM TABLET ACTIVITY



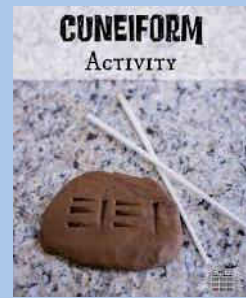

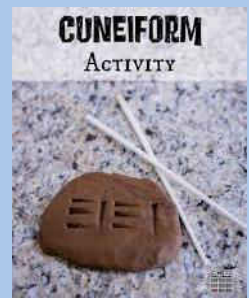

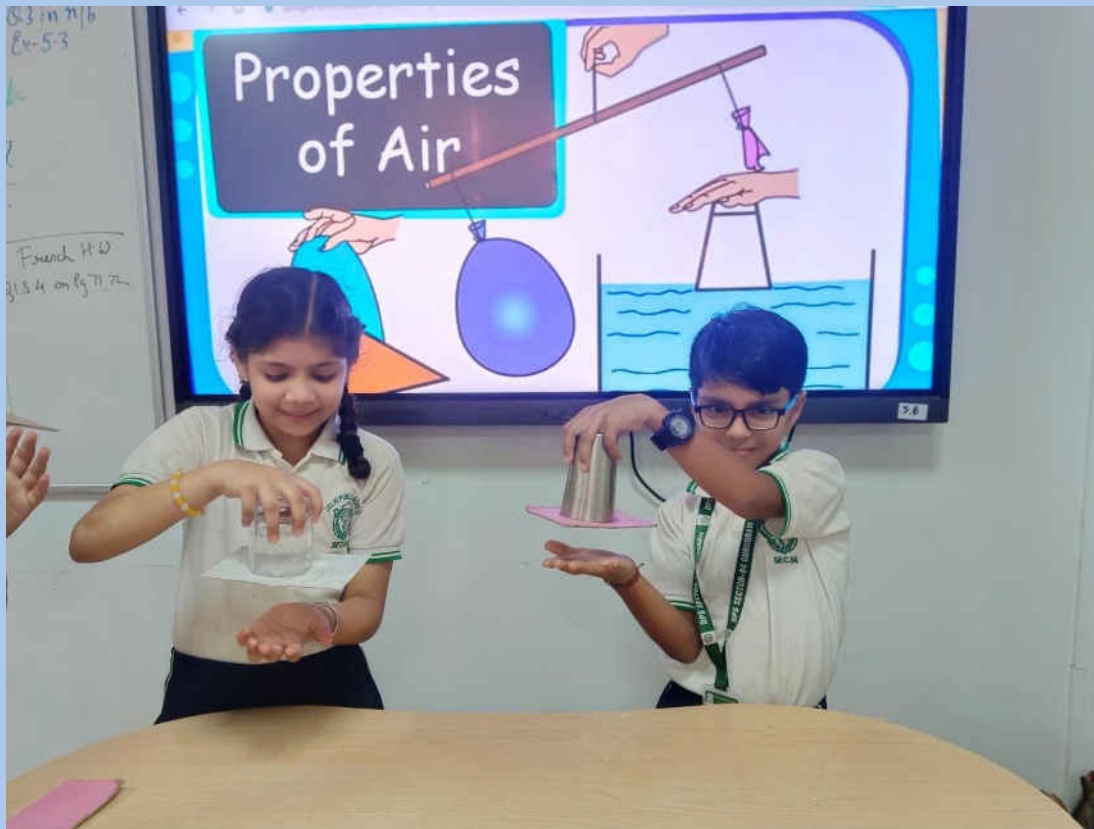


PROPERTIES OF AIR

They observed that after a few seconds, the flame went out. This showed that fire needs oxygen from air to keep burning. When the air inside the glass was used up, the flame stopped.

Through this hands-on experiment, students learned that oxygen in air is necessary for burning. The activity sparked curiosity and helped them understand science in a fun and practical way!



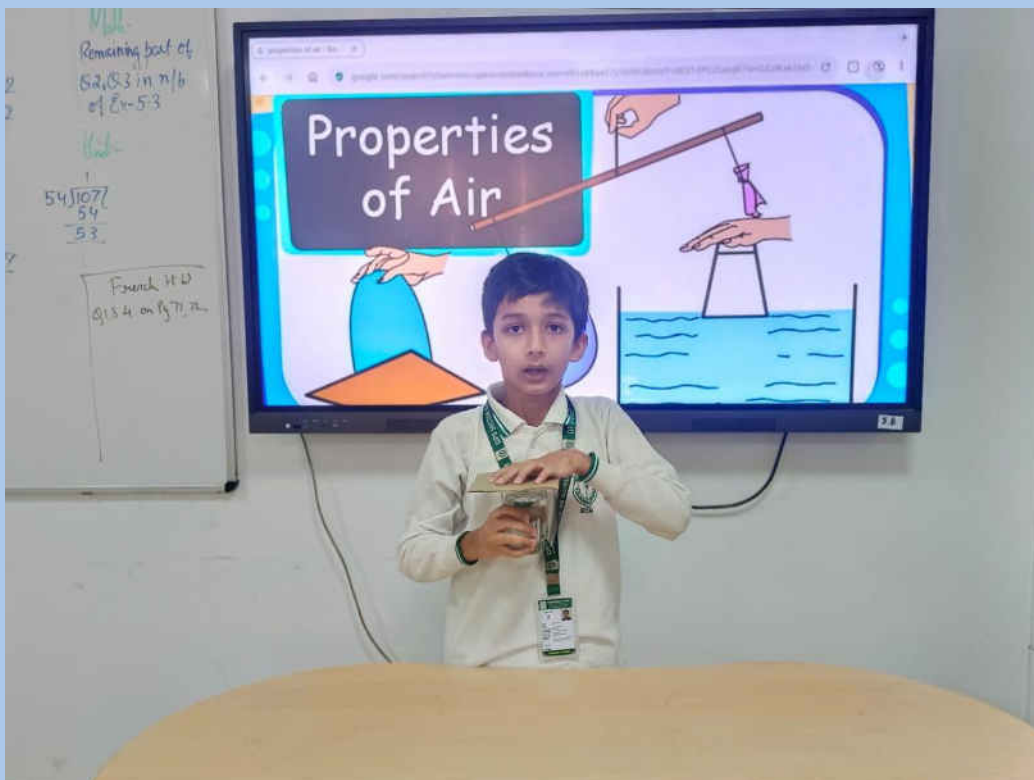

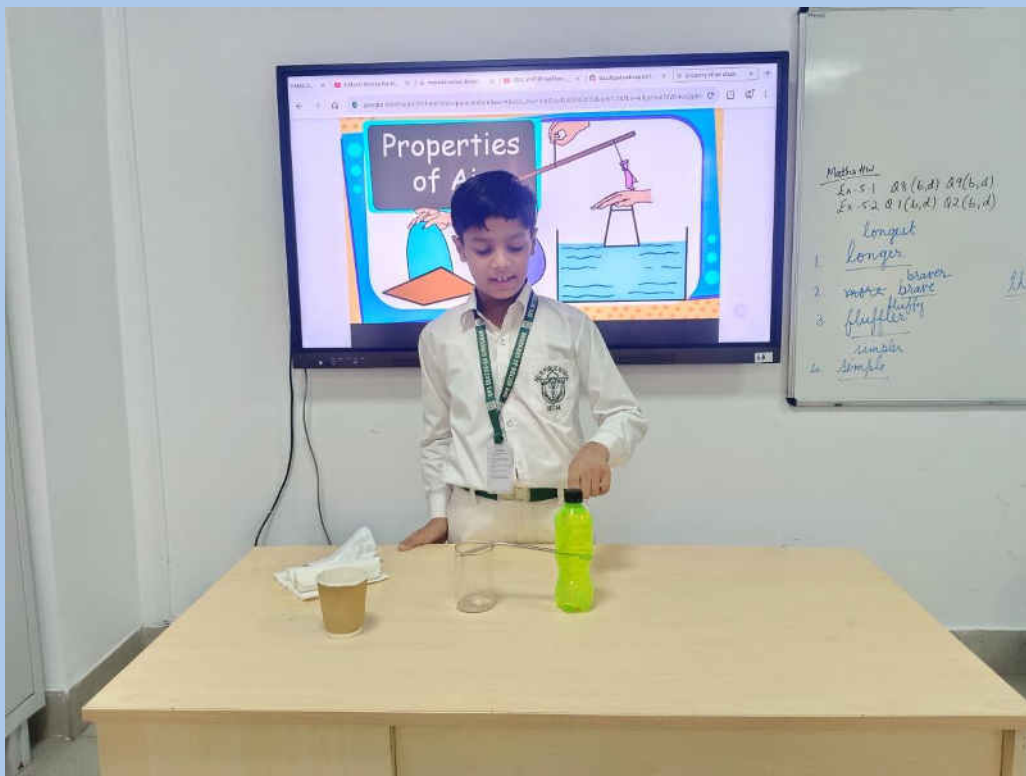

During the activity, students confidently presented their advertisements in front of the class. They explained why their product was useful and how much it cost, helping them apply money concepts in a real-life situation.

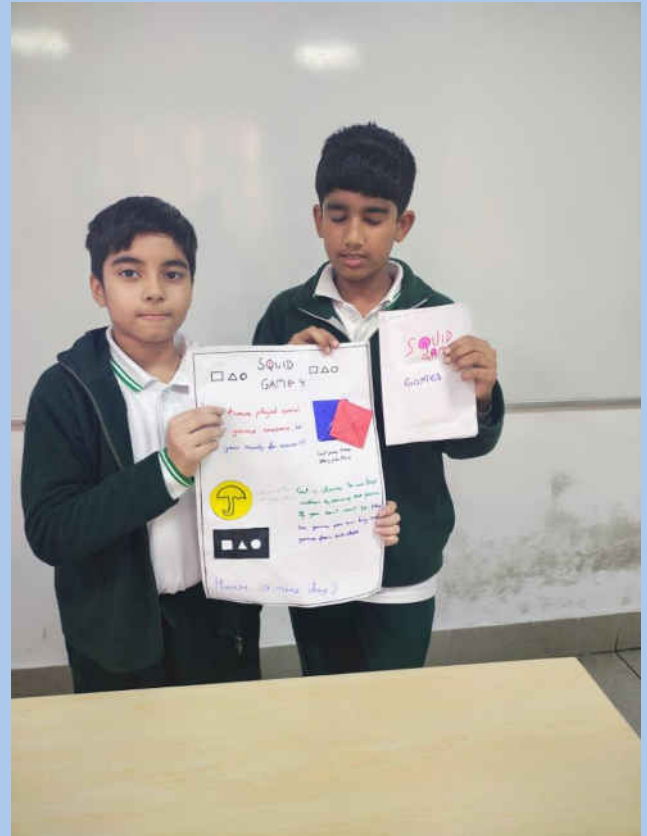
This activity enhanced students' communication skills, creativity, confidence, and practical understanding of money management. It also encouraged teamwork, critical thinking, and public speaking.

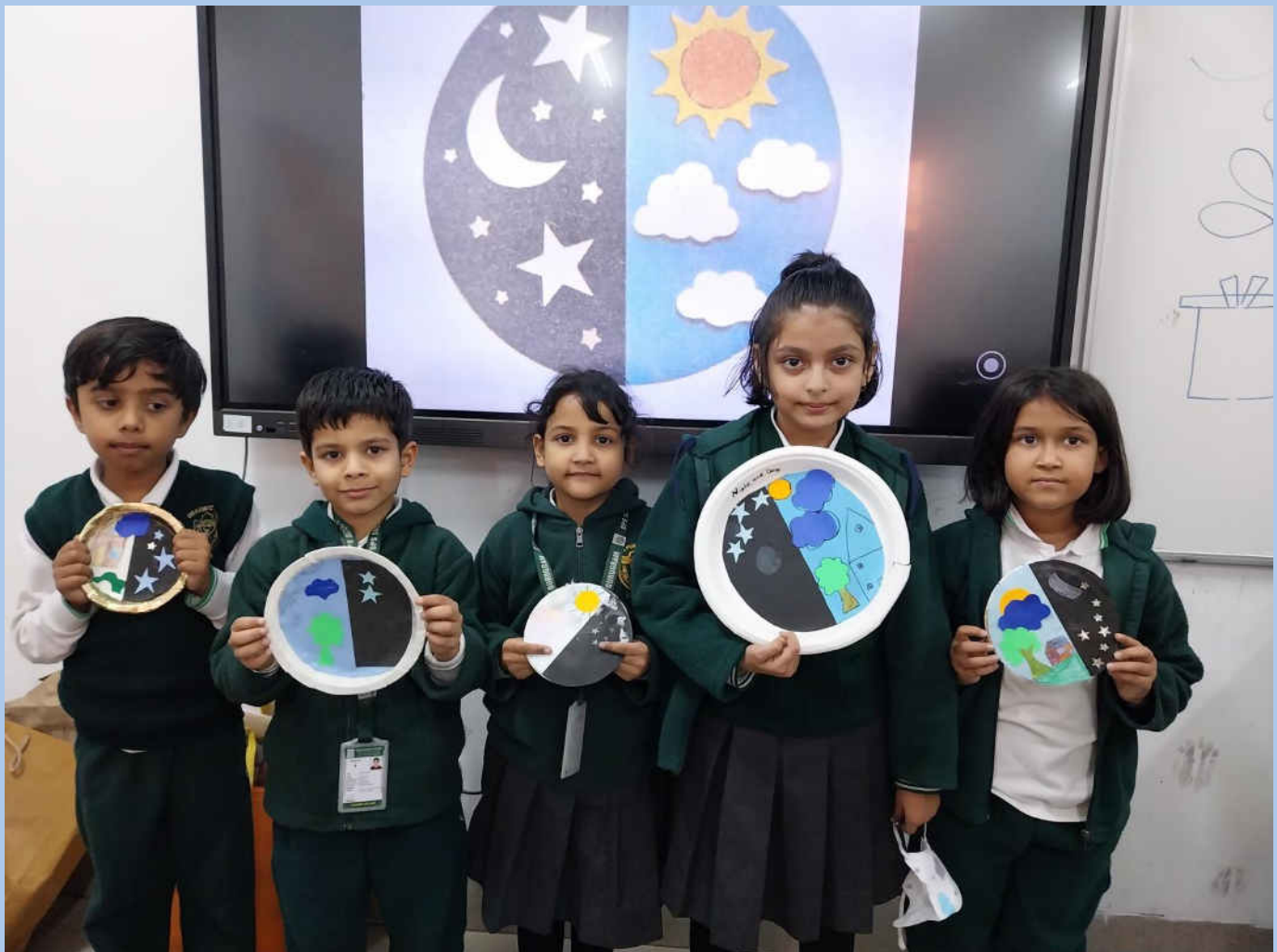
DAY AND NIGHT ACTIVITY

SHARE FAIR, SHOW CARE ACTIVITY



Students of grade 2 had hands-on learning experience on division. They engaged themselves in a creative activity - "Share Fair, Equal Share" Activity. Division is a fundamental mathematical operation that helps in equal sharing and grouping of objects. To provide students with hands-on experience, they got 10 bindis and a cut lady finger for a flower print to solve division problems given by the teacher.

They were asked to draw 10 plates in an A4 sheet and distribute bindis equally by sticking in the 10 plates. Also they represented 12 flowers equally distributed among 4 flower pots. Students observed that if the bindis and flowers were divided equally, then there were no remainder.

This activity helped them understand division as equal sharing and repeated subtraction. Students were actively engaged, and the visual, tactile and creative experience strengthened their problem-solving and logical thinking skills.

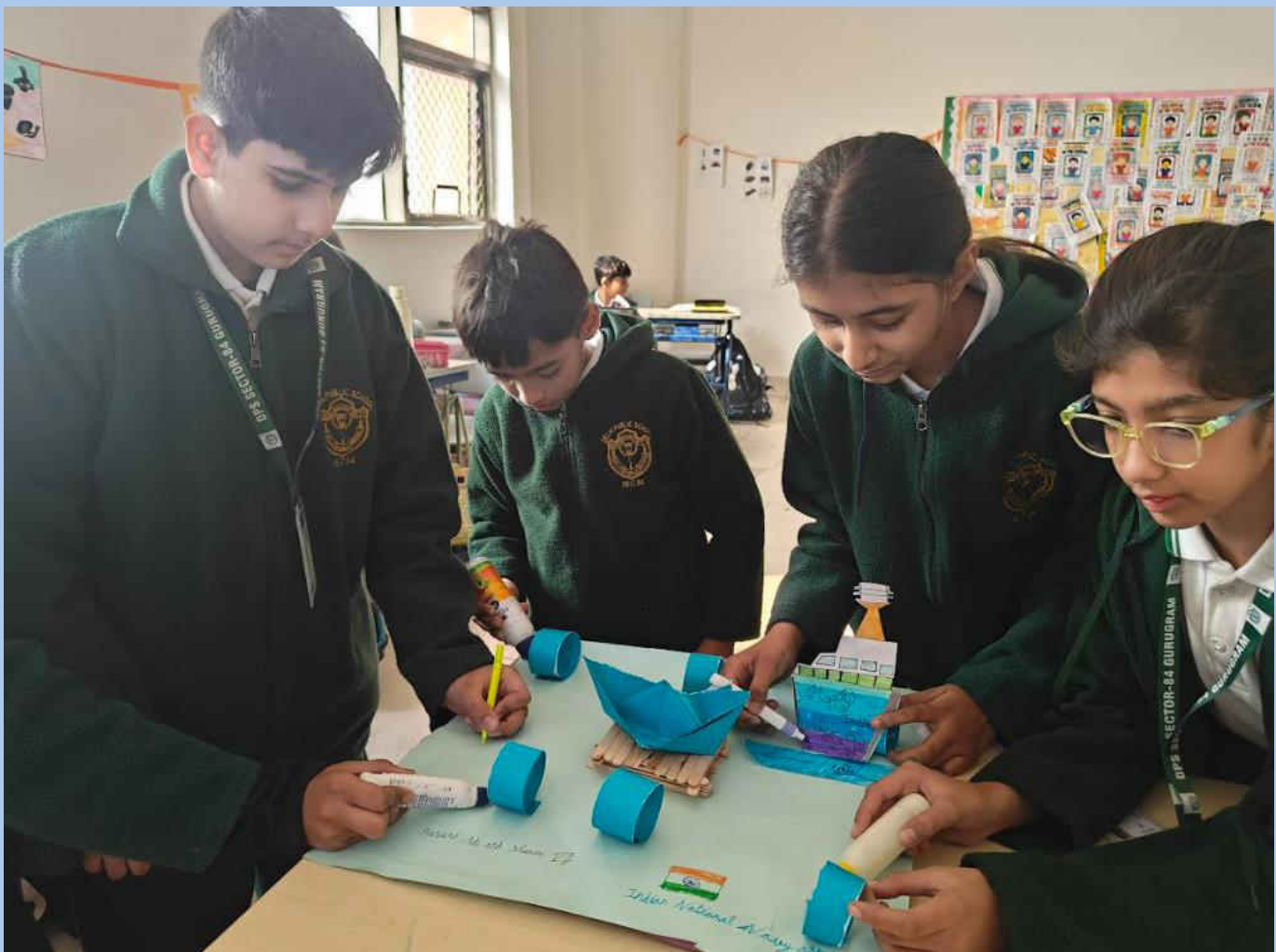
INDIAN NAVY DAY
