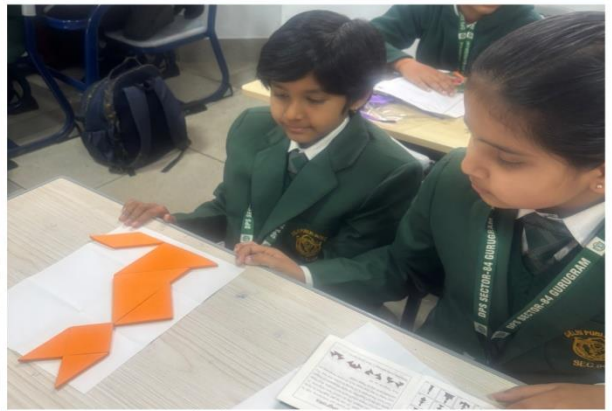
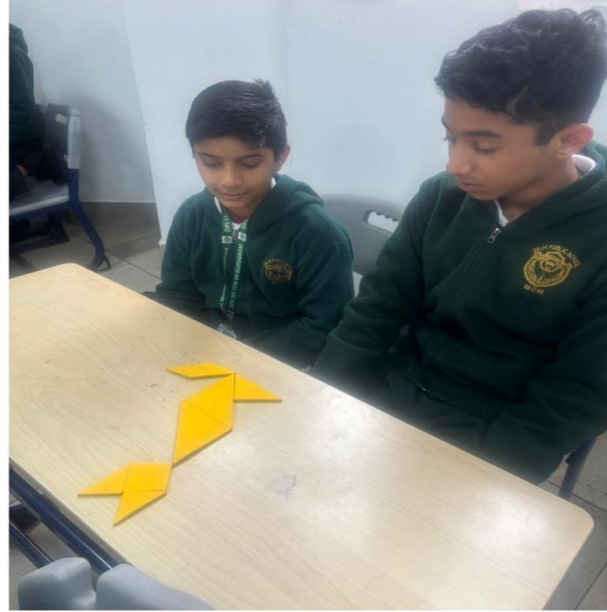
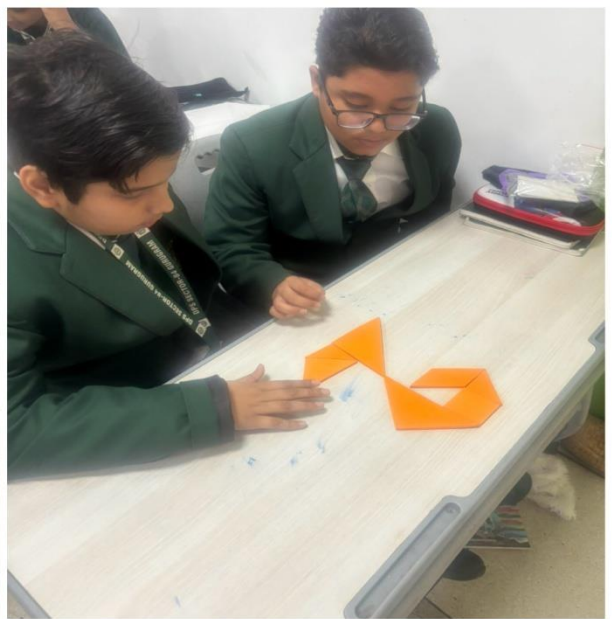
MATH CLUB ACTIVITY

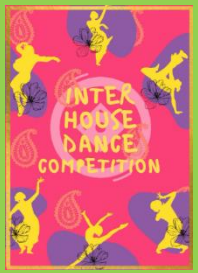

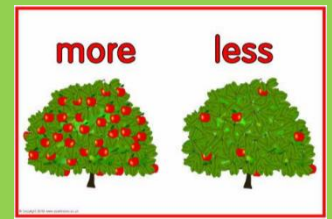

The concept of 'More' and 'Less' was introduced using pictures and a simple story on the smart board, helping children understand the idea in an engaging and visual way.

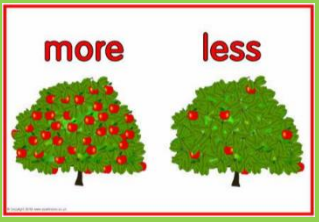
This was followed by an exciting floor game, where kids actively participated by observing, comparing, and identifying which group had more and which had less.

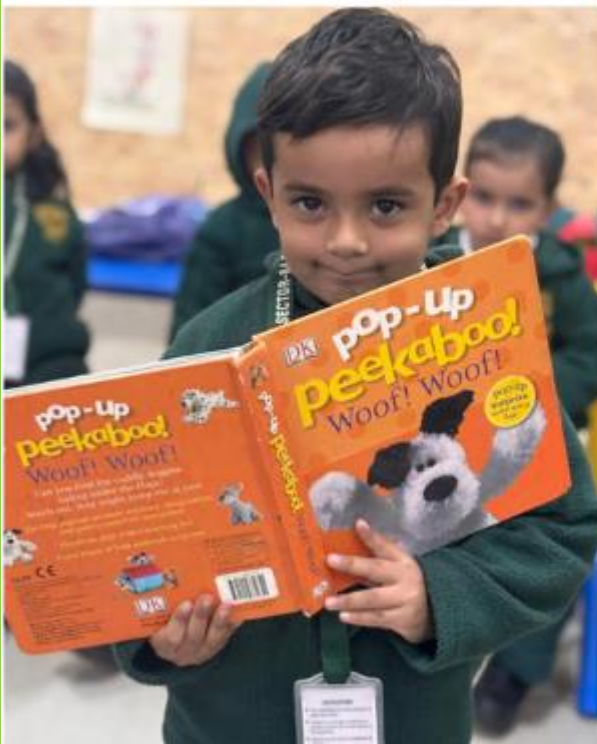

The kids looked absolutely lovely in their bright yellow attire, adding more color, and cheer to the celebration.



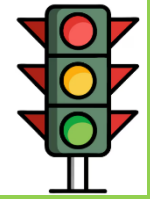

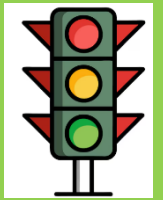

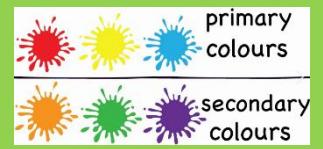
The activity not only enhanced their knowledge but also encouraged responsible behavior as future road users. Students enjoyed learning while developing awareness about road safety.





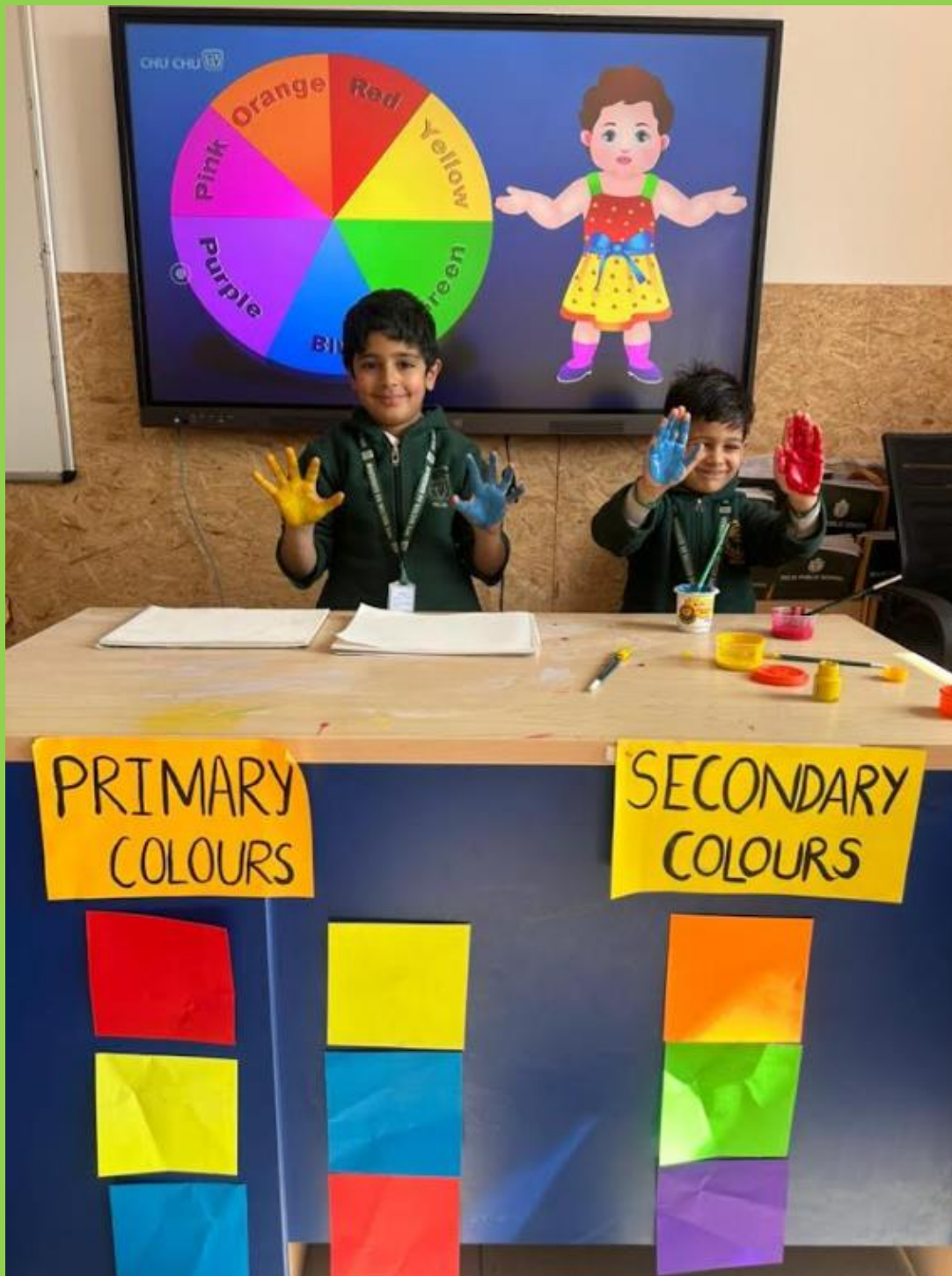
TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND SIGNS

STORY NARRATION



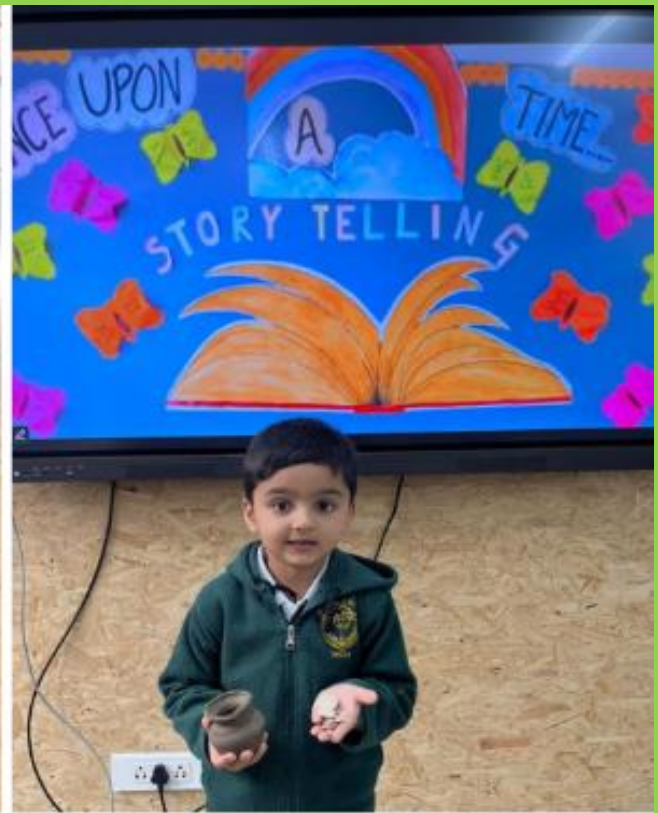
A fun story narration activity was held for Preparatory students on 28 January 2026 at DPS 84. The aim was to boost creativity, language skills, and confidence.
