

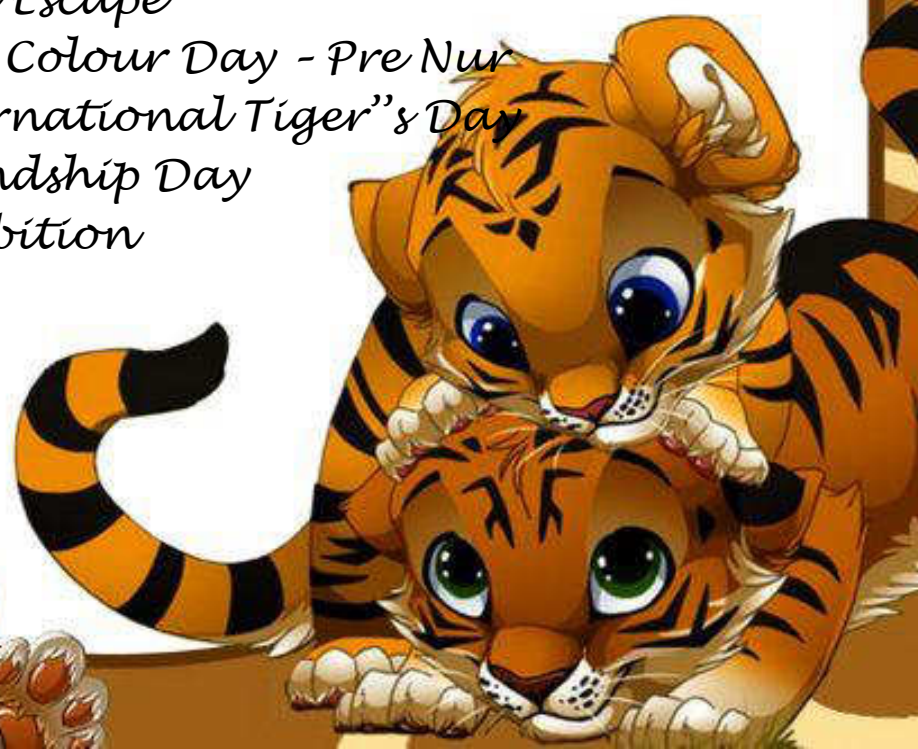

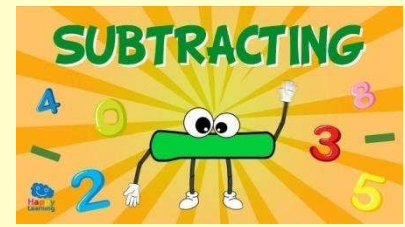

## SUBTRACTION TRAIN ACTIVITY



To make the concept of subtraction engaging and fun, the students of Grade II participated in an exciting Subtraction Train Activity. This hands-on activity turned a mathematical concept into a creative and interactive learning experience.

Each student began by creating and coloring their own train, adding a personal and artistic element to the task. The engine of the train carried a number, and students rolled a dice to subtract the number on the dice from the engine number. The difference was then written in the next coach of the train. This process was repeated to complete the entire train, turning each subtraction step into a visual journey.

- Fine motor skills through coloring and drawing

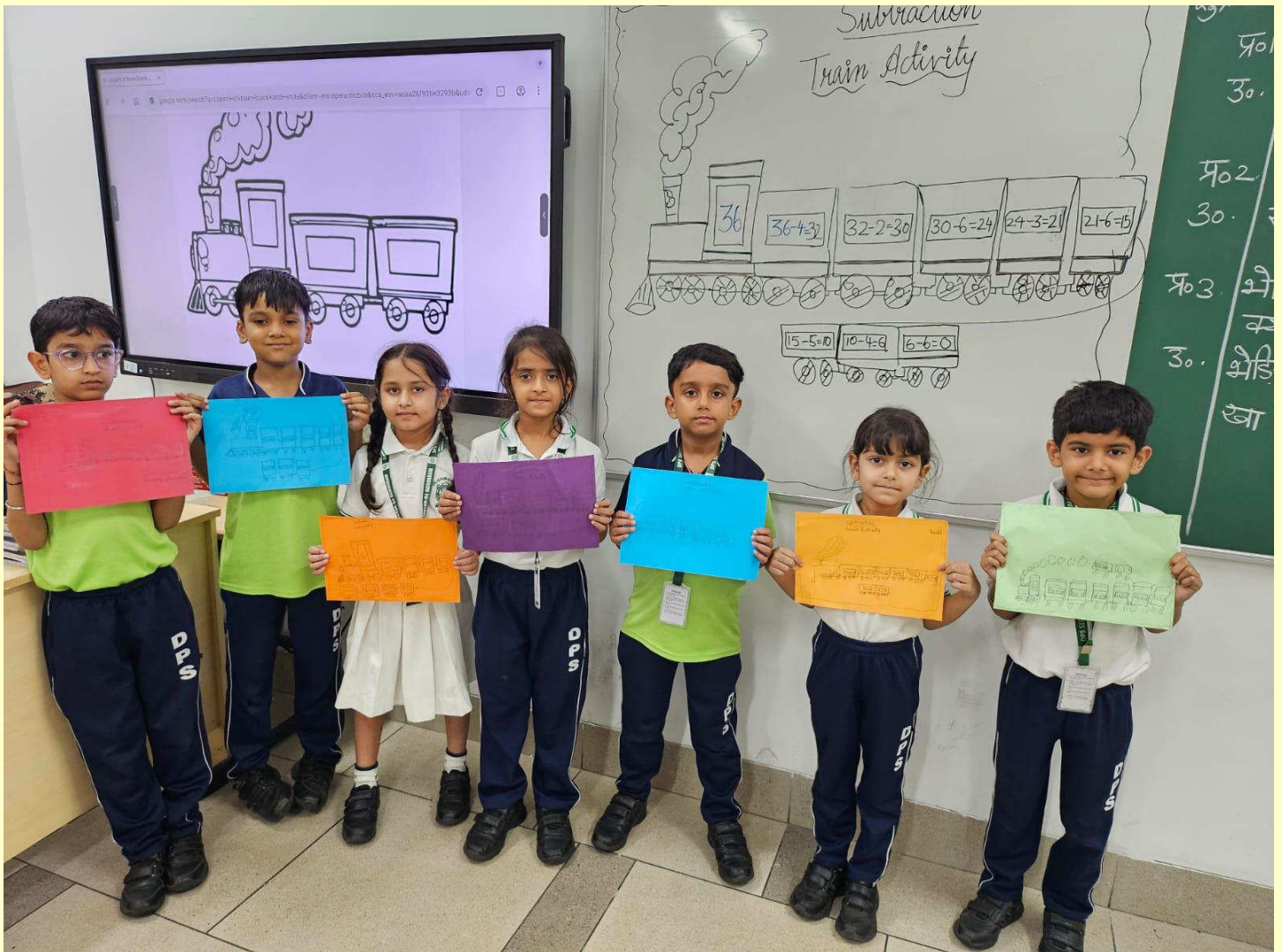
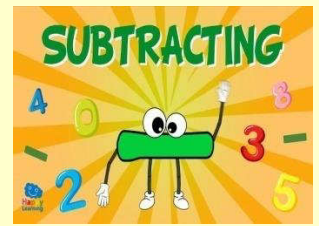
The Subtraction Train Activity proved to be a delightful blend of learning and fun, encouraging students to explore math in a meaningful and enjoyable way.

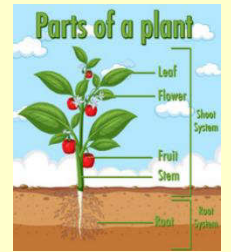

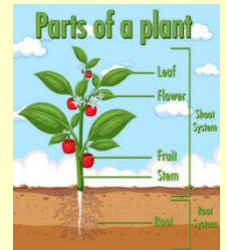
### Learning Through Play!

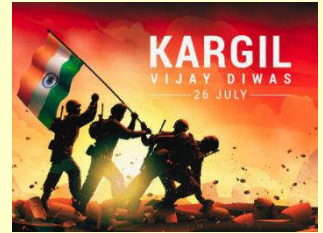

## KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS CELEBRATION



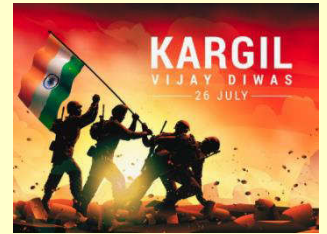

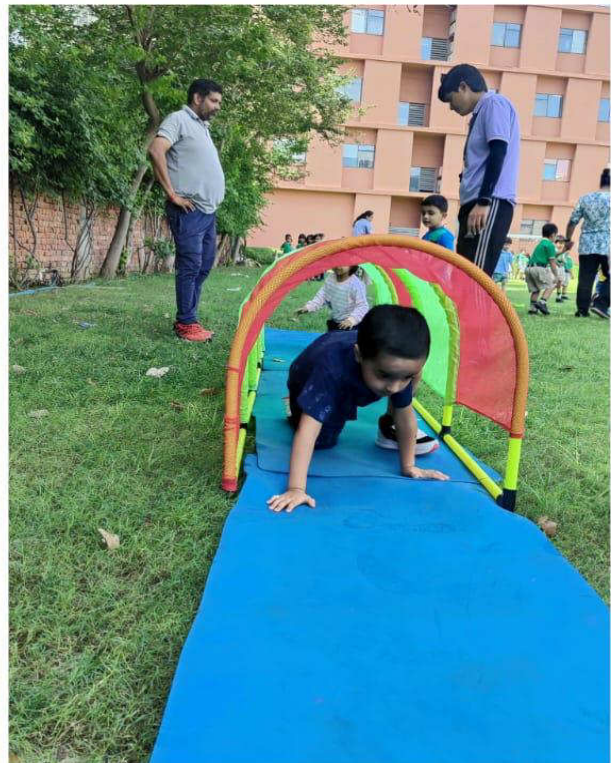

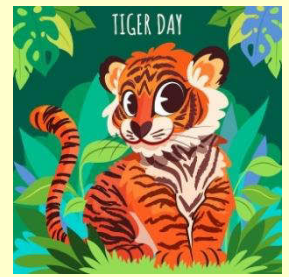

## INTERNATIONAL TIGER'S DAY



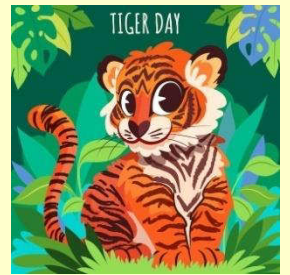

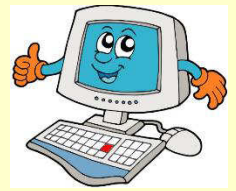

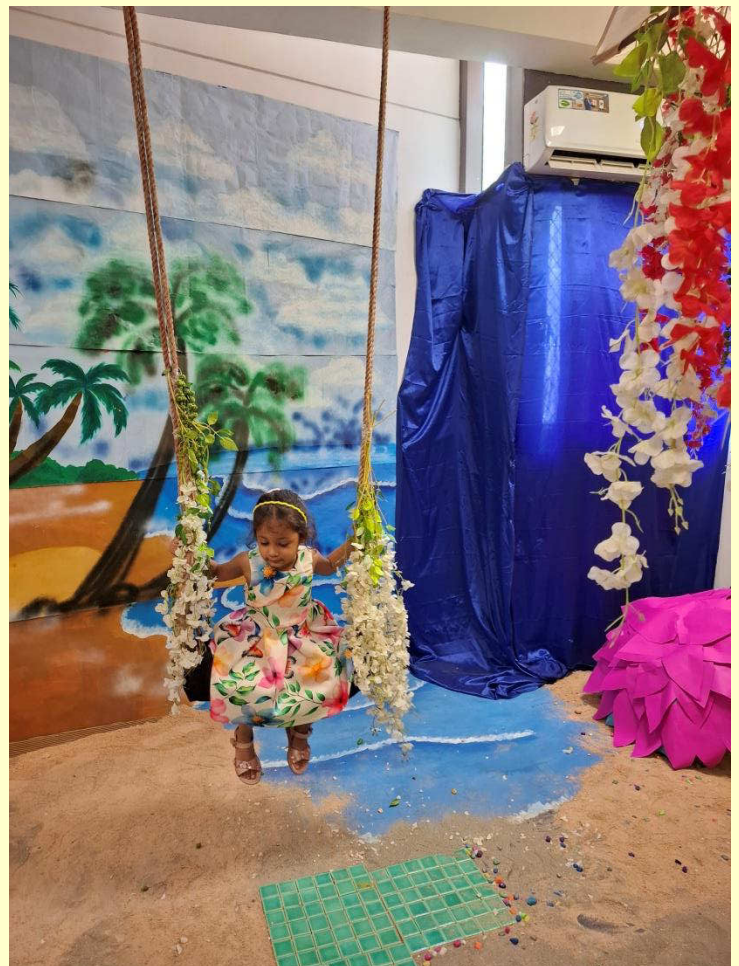
