SHARE FAIR – EQUAL SHARE



Students of Grade 2 participated in an engaging hands-on activity titled “Share Fair – Equal Share” to strengthen their understanding of the concept of division. Division, being an essential mathematical operation involving equal sharing and grouping, was introduced through a fun and creative approach.

To make the learning experience concrete and enjoyable, each child was given 10 bindis and a cut ladyfinger for flower printing. They were asked to draw 10 plates on an A4 sheet and distribute the bindis equally among the plates by sticking them one by one. They also created 12 flower prints and shared them equally among 4 flower pots.

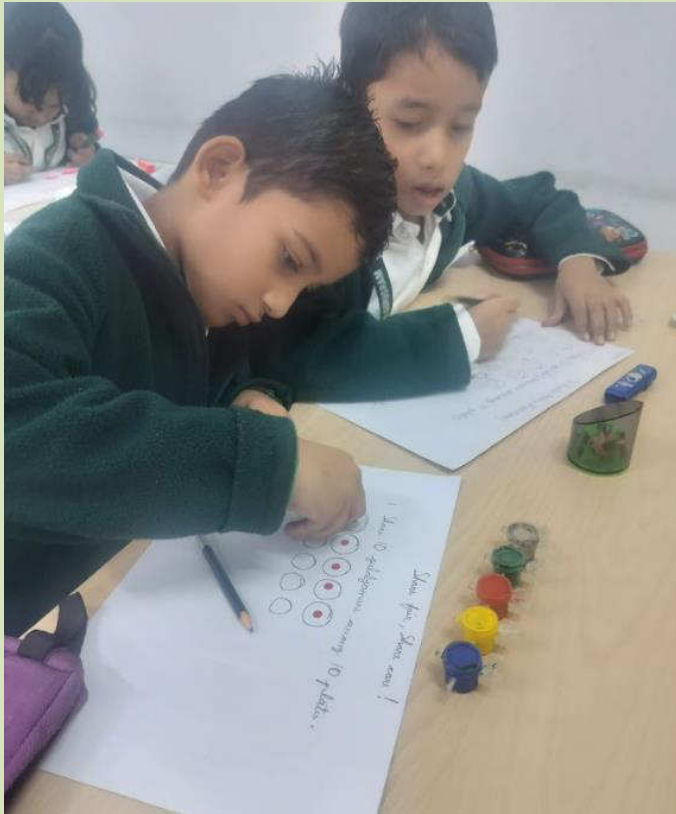
Through these tasks, students discovered that when objects are shared equally, no remainder is left—helping them visualize division as equal sharing and repeated subtraction.

The activity was highly interactive, allowing children to learn through visual, tactile, and creative exploration. Students participated enthusiastically, and the experience significantly enhanced their problem-solving skills, logical thinking, and conceptual clarity in division.

GURUPURAB CELEBRATION

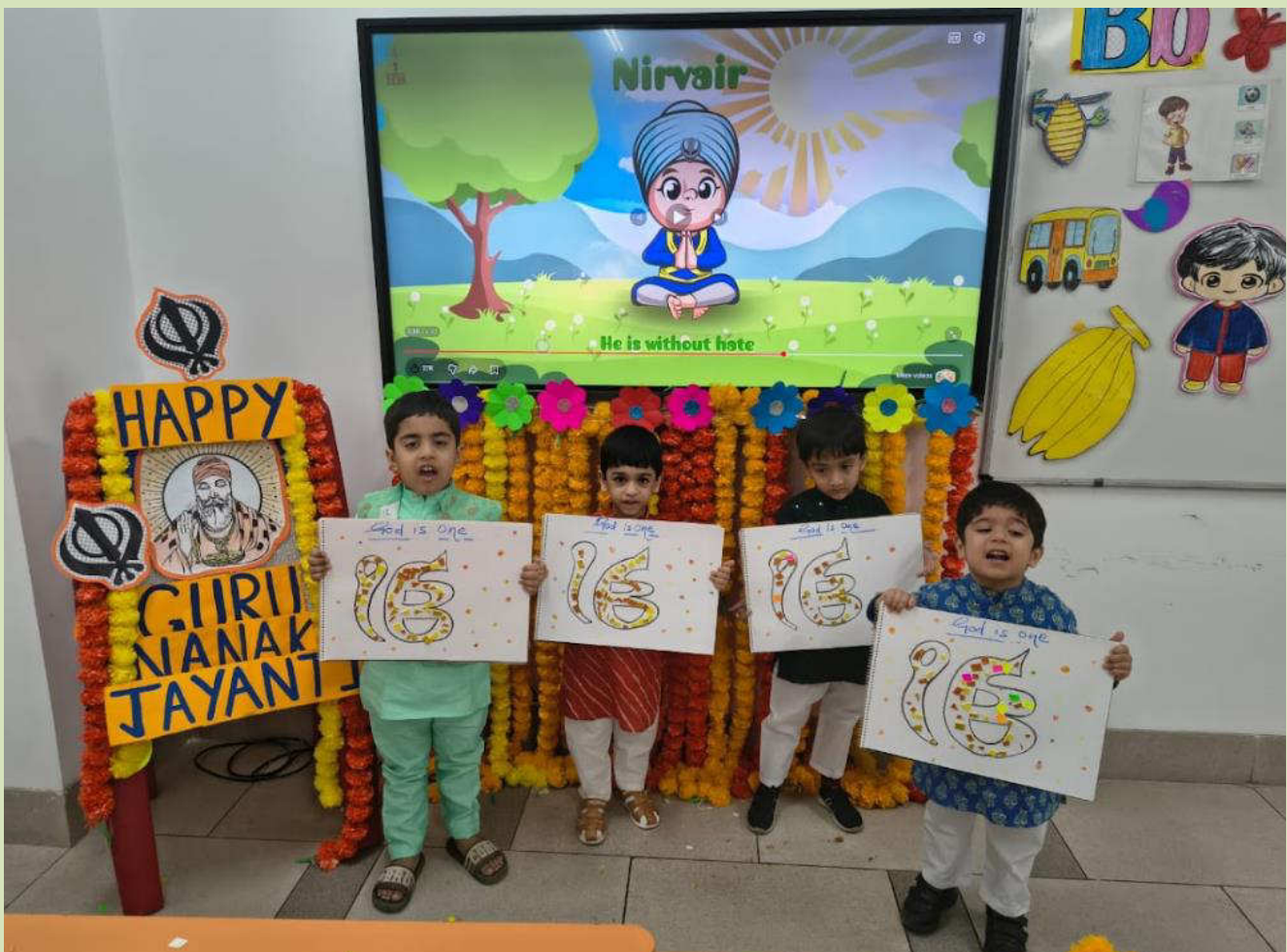


Our little ones celebrated the birth anniversary of Guru Nanak Dev Ji with great devotion and joy.

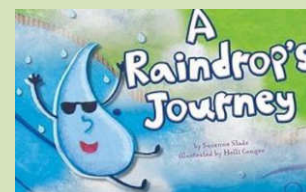

JOURNEY OF A RAINDROP

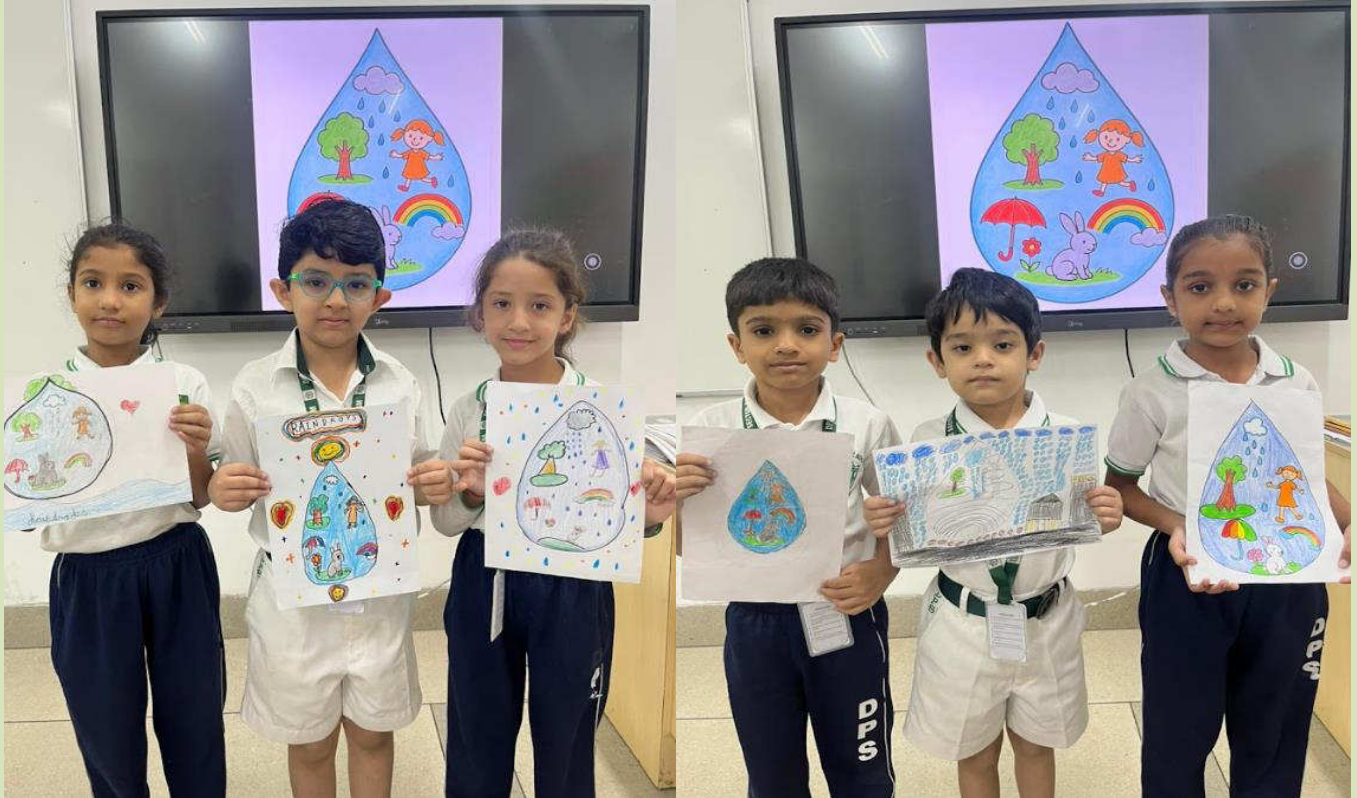
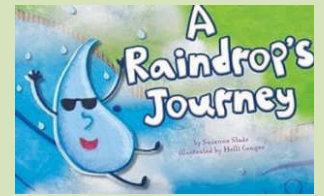

CONE SHAPE ACTIVITY



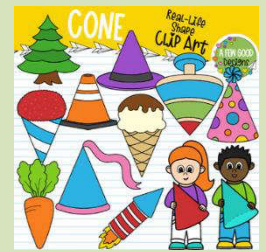
Learning about 3D shapes is very useful for kids, especially in early grades. Here's how it helps:

- It builds a strong math foundation as kids learn to identify shapes like cubes, cylinders, cones, and spheres.
- It improves spatial understanding, which is important for geometry later on.
- It improves observation and thinking skills of students as they start noticing and relating shapes in real life (ball = sphere, box = cube).
- It helps them compare, sort, and classify objects based on properties.

GERMINATION



- Learning About Germination helps children understand how plants grow- Germination shows the very first stage of a plant's life. Kids learn that plants start from seeds and need air, water, and sunlight to grow.
- It builds scientific thinking. When children observe seeds sprouting, they learn to ask questions, make predictions, and observe changes—important skills for science.
- It teaches responsibility and care. Watching seeds grow helps children understand the importance of taking care of living things by watering them and giving them proper sunlight.

Students learnt the germination through an activity conducted in the class.
